南京大學教授、博士生導師。1943年12月出生於中國上海，1960年至1965年就讀於復旦大學經濟學系，畢業後分配到南京大學任教至今。在南京大學工作期間，曾任政治學系主任、法政學院院長、公共管理學院院長、南京大學副校長。現任中國政治學會副會長、中國高校政治學學科教學指導委員會主任委員等職。

Professor, doctoral tutor of Nanjing University. He was born in Shanghai, December 1943 and studied in Dept. of Economics, Fudan University from 1960 to 1965. Since then, he has been working in Nanjing University. During his career in Nanjing University, he had been the Chair of Dept. Politics, the Dean of School of Law and Politics, the Dean of School of Public Management and the Vice-president of Nanjing University. Now, he is the Vice-chairman of Chinese Politics Association and the Chair of Chinese Universities' Politics Education Steering Committee.

Heungsuk Choi is a professor in the Department of Public Administration at Korea University. He received his bachelor in Material Science and master of public administration from Korea University. He obtained his master in political science from Purdue University, and Ph.D. in Public Administration from Syracuse University in 1993. His research interests include public management, local government, electronic government, governmental innovation system, and government reform. In those academic areas, he has published numerous journal articles, book chapters, and books. He also conducted many government-funded research projects. For example, his research on higher education policy conducted in 2009 with a sponsorship by the Korean National Research Foundation has brought about important changes in the Korean government policy toward graduate education including the Brain Korea 21 program.

Professor Choi is currently Vice President of International Affairs at Korea University. He served as the Vice Dean of Graduate School and the Vice Dean of Graduate School of Public Policy. Despite his administrative position, professor Choi is academically very much active as he currently leads such studies as comparative analysis of public service systems, cross-national comparison of public employee unions, performance management in public corporations, etc. He also directed the Brain Korea 21 Education & Research Group for Asian Public Administration Hub and the Institute of Governmental Studies up to recently.

Professor Choi has much experience working with government bodies. Some of the government organizations for which he played advisory roles include National Assembly of the Republic of Korea, Korean Ministry of Government Administration and Security, Board of Audit and Inspection, National Association of Mayors, and Seoul Metropolitan Government. He also participated in performance evaluation committees for Korean Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade, Ministry of Government Administration and Home Affairs, Office of the Prime Minister, and Seoul Metropolitan Government.

In the field of professional service, he has been serving as members of the board of trustees for major Korean academic associations in the field of public administration and public policy, including Korean Association for Public Administration, Korean Association for Policy Studies, and Korea Association for Local Government Studies. He also was the editor-in-chief of Journal of Local government, and was an editorial board member for Korean Public Administrative Review, Journal of Korean Association for Policy Studies, and Journal of Comparative Policy Analysis, and so on.
